Dr Mahyar Amjadi

The Medical Council of NSW has imposed a range of conditions on the medical registration of Sydney plastic surgeon, Dr Mahyar Amjadi. These conditions are designed to protect Dr Amjadi's patients and the public generally. These restrictions are effective from 1 October 2019.

Dr Amjadi may not undertake any body-contouring surgery. This includes surgery involving abdominoplasty, arm lifts, buttock lifts, liposuction, lipectomy and thigh lifts. He is also prohibited from acting as a surgical assistant for these procedures.

The full list of conditions on Dr Amjadi's registration are publically available on the Australian Health Practitioner Regulation Agency (AHPRA) Register of Practitioners.

All conditions on Dr Mahyar Amjadi's registration will remain in place pending investigation by the NSW Health Care Complaints Commission (HCCC) and the outcome of any disciplinary proceedings.

The Council will not be making any further public comments at this time.

Background

The Medical Council works in collaboration with the (HCCC) to receive and manage complaints about registered doctors and medical students in NSW. The Council's paramount legal obligation is to protect the public. It deals with doctors whose conduct, performance or health may represent a risk to the public.
